This lightweight and portable Speech Generating Device (SGD) allows the person who is Deaf or Hard of Hearing the ability to communicate with anyone using typed text to speech. The UbiDuo 2 SGD helps eliminate isolation, stress, frustration, and communication barriers. It enables the users to express their needs, thoughts, and emotions seamlessly in the same way others communicate in a conversation.
